Antarctica threatened by increasing ice-free areas

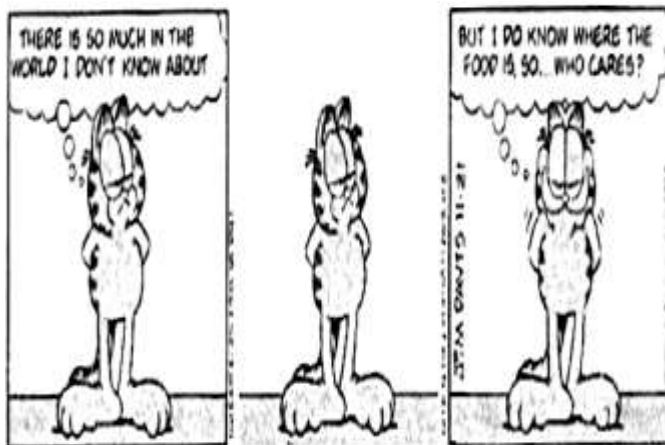
