0 Conditional

Used for **present**
real/factual situations

Present simple

If it rains,

Present simple

the ground **gets** wet.

1st Conditional

Used for **future**
Real/factual situations

1st Conditional

If I have enough Money,

1st Conditional

I **will** buy a car.

2nd Conditional

Used for **present** or
future unreal situations

2nd Conditional

If I had Money,

2nd Conditional

I **would** give you.
(but I don't have money)

For example:

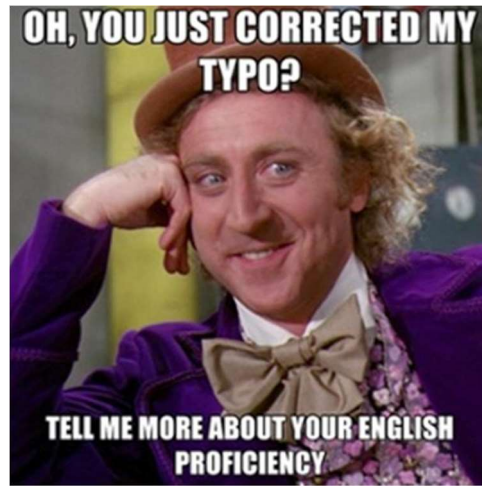
